## Fighting for a Better CUNY

We are the faculty and professional staff of The City University of New York. We are proud to teach CUNY's 275,000 students and help generations of New Yorkers to fulfill their dream of a college education. But we've been without a union contract for *five years*. **CUNY's failure to provide a raise and negotiate a contract puts the quality of education in danger.**

We're protesting outside Hunter College to demand immediate action on our contract and marching past the homes of the "1%" to demand an alternative to anti-worker, anti-student politics.

While ***CUNY community college tuition has gone up 43%*** since our last raise and the ***CUNY chancellor's pay has risen by 49%***, ***our salary schedules have increased 0%***.

We need a contract with salary increases now. Our pay must be competitive with comparable colleges and universities to recruit and retain the best faculty and staff for CUNY students.

**CUNY management must stop stalling at the bargaining table.**

The CUNY bosses have put no money on the table for raises or workload improvements, and have made no real movement on the union's non-economic demands. Albany politicians share blame with CUNY management for the lack of an economic offer, but the CUNY bosses could negotiate to improve our working and teaching conditions right now.

That's why we are calling for immediate movement on a contract that helps to build a better CUNY.

**Fair pay and improved working conditions for us mean better learning conditions for our students.**
