Dear Dr. Davis:

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, \$1,397,427 in increased funding for travel that had been negotiated as part of the 2017-2023 PSC-CUNY collective bargaining agreement for the period January 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, was not allocated.

The University and PSC/CUNY agree that the sum of \$1,397,427 that was not disbursed to the Colleges will be allocated to the Colleges in accordance with the following schedule:

October 15, 2022

\$698,713.50

July 1, 2023

\$698,713.50

These funds will be allocated to the Colleges in accordance with the formula for the July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023 disbursement. This will confirm that conference and seminar registration, which is one of the allowable expense codes for the use of travel funds, may include registration for online programs. Registration fees for online programs may only be covered by the October 15, 2022, and July 1, 2023 disbursements provided to the Colleges in accordance with the terms of this letter agreement based upon the extraordinary conditions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The parties agree that with the disbursement of the funds set forth above, the University will have fulfilled all of its obligations pursuant to the terms of Article 28 ("Travel Allowances") for the January 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021 period.

This constitutes the entire agreement entered into by the parties and it cannot be supplemented, amended, or modified in any manner, except in a writing signed by both of the parties. It is not a precedent for any other matters between the parties.
