## II. President's report and discussion (including written) - J. Davis

# A. Contract campaign

The union has been organizing the first contract rally at CUNY Central on Monday, February 27, the day before the expiration of the 2017-2023 contract.

The contract action will express PSC's collective strength to management as we head into contract negotiations.

The union has launched a member petition, telling CUNY to come to the table to negotiate. The petition has nearly 1,800 signatures. The PSC leadership has requested that CUNY begin scheduling bargaining sessions but have not yet landed on a date.

# B. NYS/NYC Budget campaigns

The PSC sent two 8-member teams on lobby visits in Albany on February 9. President Davis urged DA members to participate in lobbying on Tuesday, March 9, at a rally inside the Capitol.

PSC members are engaging CUNY students with a more formalized mechanism in the Powerful Partnerships grant program. Our coalition partners in the CUNY Rising Alliance are vocal allies advocating for the CUNY community. The prime sponsors of the New Deal for CUNY, Senator Gounardes and Assemblymember Reyes, are forceful and persistent; they've helped us to organize more than 70 legislators to support the bill. Our state affiliate NYSUT has launched a campaign for a New Deal for Higher Education, calling for \$4.7 billion in new investments in SUNY and CUNY.

The PSC is filming a video ad about the budget and the New Deal for CUNY that will air in subsequent weeks in Albany and on social media, featuring Hunter College student Riya Patel, BMCC student Abigail Essiful-Stiles, and Medgar Evers College professor (and grievance counselor) Victoria Chevalier.

#### C. CUNY Savings Plan

Every college was directed to submit a plan within one month to achieve 5-6% savings in FY24. The university-wide target is \$100 million, in addition to the \$75 million that he reported the colleges having cut in FY23. The union must organize against these cuts and continue to organize to improve the state and city budgets for CUNY.

#### D. NYC retiree health insurance

Mayor Adams has threatened to unilaterally move all municipal retirees currently enrolled in traditional Medicare/Senior Care into Medicare Advantage but he has not done so yet. The City Council refused his request to change the NYC Administrative Code to allow the city to begin charging premiums on those who would opt to remain in Medicare/Senior Care.

Two issues remain:

- Nothing in the Administrative Code as it's been interpreted by the courts says that Senior Care must be preserved and the Mayor could try to eliminate Senior Care.
- The city has taken the position that wages won't be bargained until savings are achieved on health care. This might pose a risk to the economic package offered to the municipal unions.

## E. Membership report and campaign plan - A. Vásquez

A. Vásquez reported on membership numbers for the union. The union's membership campaign is underway. Chapter Chairs have received lists of Non-members. New members will receive welcome packets.

#### F. Nominations for Vacant EC Positions:

The PSC follows the Election Rules approved by the DA. As announced, nominations will be taken from the floor of the meeting. All delegates or their alternates are eligible to vote. If there is more than one eligible candidate and all candidates consent, an election will be conducted electronically by secret ballot administered by PSC staff.

## A. December Report

December 2022 Financial Statement Total Operating Income: \$1,783,000 Total Operating Expenses: \$2,005,000

Surplus (Deficit): \$ (222,000)

Year-to-date (4 months):

As of December 31, 2022, the financial statement shows a four-month surplus of \$50,000 when year-to-date expenditures are compared with year-to-date income. PSC spent \$6,610,000 and \$6,660,000 was received over the four-month period.
