### Full-Time and Part-Time Faculty, and Graduate Workers

Educators in more than a dozen full-time titles perform teaching, research, guidance and departmental service duties. Graduate Assistants work in teaching and non-teaching roles. Teaching adjuncts in four titles and educators in another 12 part-time titles teach or perform related duties, but are hired by CUNY colleges as contingent workers.

#### **Professional Staff**

Higher Education Officer Series employees (HEOs)
perform planning, research, coordination,
administrative and professional duties to support CUNY
offices, programs and centers. They are full-time
workers with many different functional titles. NonTeaching Adjuncts (NTAs) do similar work on a parttime basis. College Laboratory Technicians (CLTs),
working in full- and part-time titles, perform a wide
variety of critical lab functions, creative pedagogical
support roles, and technical duties.
