Pursuant to an agreement with the Professional Staff Congress City University of New York, herein “PSC CUNY” the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as the “Administrator,” agreed to conduct an Officer Election via online voting.

Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven (777) voting instructions and Personal Identification Numbers (“PINs”) were mailed to members on Tuesday, April 1, 2025. Voting instructions and Personal Identification Numbers (“PINs”) were emailed to members on Monday, March 31, 2025. Voters were also provided the option to call and request that a paper ballot be sent in lieu of online voting. PSC CUNY provided the list of eligible voters.

Online voting occurred beginning at 9:00 AM ET on Tuesday, April 1, 2025, and concluded at 5:00 PM ET on Thursday, April 24, 2025. The deadline to receive mail ballots was set for 5:00 PM ET on Thursday, April 24, 2025.

Results for online voting were downloaded by the Administrator after the conclusion of online voting. The tabulation of mail ballots took place at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, at the Administrator’s office, located at 120 Broadway, Concourse Level, New York, NY 10271. Prior to the deadline, the Administrator received online ballots and mail ballot envelopes as follows:

College of Staten Island: 308 (*Online Votes*) + 1 (*Mail ballot envelopes*) = **309 total**
